

H3 Subjects & Application

Students may apply to do a H3 subject if they have done well in their overall examinations at the end of JC 1.

Selection Criteria

- Done well for all subjects
- A high "A" in the H2 subject to be offered at H3 level
- Pass in Aptitude Test, if any



University Requirements

NUS, NTU, SMU, SUTD, SIT and SUSS consider results in 3 H2 and 1 H1 content subjects, GP and PW and at least an "S" grade for Mother Tongue.

Taking 4 H2 content subjects will not give students an added advantage as the result of the least performing H2 will be converted to the equivalent of a H1 subject.



Grading System

The grading system for H1 and H2 subjects is as follows.

Grade	Marks

NUS Science / Nursing	Pass in any two of the following H2 subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Computing, Physics & Math

NUS Engineering	H2 pass in Mathematics & either Physics / Chemistry
NUS Chem/Environ Engineering	H2 pass in Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics
NTU Engineering	H2 pass in Mathematics and Physics or Chemistry or Biology or Computing
NTU Chem & Biomolecular Eng	H2 Mathematics and Chemistry and H1 or "O" level pass in Physics.








Step 8: For Subject Combinations






Step 8: For Subject Combinations






Step 8: Subject Combinations that is being offered






Step 8: Making your choice (H2 Subject)






Step 8: Making your choice (H1 subject)




