

AUs: Who is eligible to apply?


Admission is based on academic merit, aptitude (passion, attitude, interests, strengths etc.) & open competition amongst all eligible applicants.

Students must also fulfil the subject prerequisites for the courses which they wished to be considered for.

Uni	Degree Course	Pre-Requisites
NUS	Engineering	H2 pass in Mathematics or Further Mathematics. Please refer to https://cde.nus.edu.sg/ for details.
NUS	Medicine	H2 pass in Chemistry and either Biology or Physics.
NTU	Psychology	A good grade in H1 Mathematics and a good grade in General Paper (GP)
NTU	Accountancy	H1 Level pass in Mathematics, or 'O' Level/equivalent pass in Additional Mathematics
SMU	Law	Passes in all, including GP grade of A or B & interview / writing test
SUTD	Architecture & Sustainable Design	Good passes in all, preferably taken H2 Math and H2 Physics / Chemistry (but will consider H1 or O Level results too).
SIT	Physiotherapy	Good pass in 2 of the following H2 subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics. Minimum D in GP and have to clear the Mandatory Medical Examination.
SUSS	Early Childhood Education with Minor	3 H2 Passes, be certified medically fit for study and to work with children

How can I find these info?

Ask your child to Google: "NUS Subject Pre-requisites" (you can substitute NUS for other unis)



In addition to fulfilling admission requirements for the applicant category that you belong to, you

Important: Can your child cope?

As a parent, how can I help?

- Discuss with your child:
 - Will the Uni course lead him/her to his/her career goal?
 - Does he/she have an interest / strength in this course?
 - Can he/she score well in this course?
- Keep in mind that the A-Level syllabus is much more difficult than O-Levels, so consider your child's strengths and interests before deciding on the final subject combination.

Be realistic, but still consider their interests, strengths and career aspirations

Be open-minded, explore courses and universities that they might not have considered
